800 Freephone services

The availability of service will be subject to the willingness of each user of the 800 number to receive calls from the Other Licensed Operator.

700 calls to Information Service Providers

The customer tariffs for calls to 700 numbers are currently set by the individual Information Service Providers for specific numbers. Charges to the OLO will therefore be set by commercial negotiation, based on the OLO's costs for originating calls in its network, the Information Service Providers' charges and stc charges .

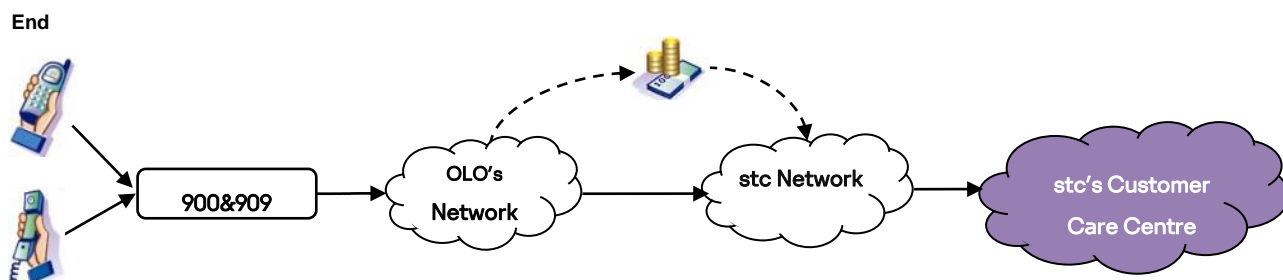
Cost Sharing Call Services ("9200 Service")

For the Cost Sharing Call Services provided by stc, OLO shall use the service for its own users.

As per CITC decision number 466/1442, the Interconnection Termination Charge for 9200 Service is "Zero" for all Local Operators.

Voice Call Termination to stc's Customer Care Centre

The service enables OLO's customers to access stc's Customer Care Centre where the call shall be handed over from OLO's network to stc's network, routed to stc's Call Centre and answered by stc's operators. stc shall convey calls to Customer Care at the same quality of service as stc conveys similar calls originated on stc's network. The service will be provided as shown in the diagram below:

Call Termination to Government and other business entities

- The service enables OLO's customers to access either non-geographic short codes starting with "19" (structured of 4, 5, or 6 digits) or non-geographic "special" short codes starting with "9"(structured of 3 digits), which could be free-of-charge for end users upon request from the government and other business entities. Such calls shall be terminated to stc's customers of Government bodies and other Business entities. It is offered as follows:

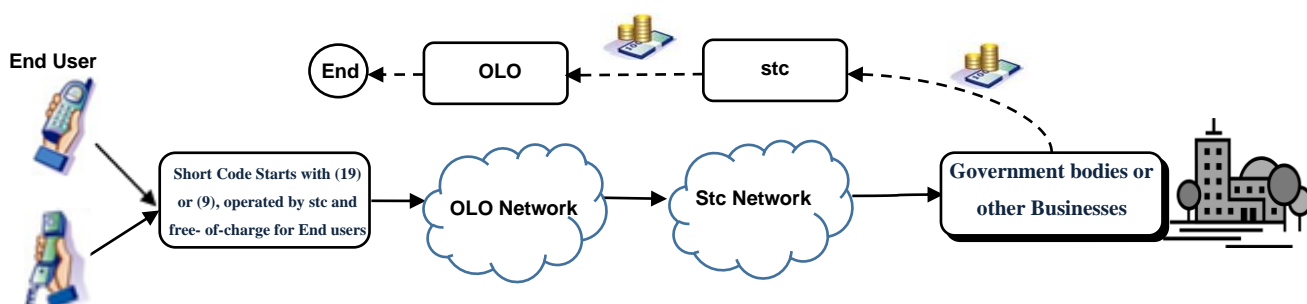
stc pays back an amount of SAR0.10\Min to the OLOs from which the call is initiated and terminated to such special short codes

- For short codes starting with "19" (structured of 4, 5, or 6 digits) and not free of charges for the end user, stc charges the OLOs from which the call is initiated and terminated to such special short codes an amount equals to the FTR specified by CITC.
